

Geneva Township  
Regular Meeting  
July 9, 2025

Chairman Mills called the meeting to order at 9:03 AM. The pledge of Alliance was recited.

Roll Call: Mr. Mills and Mr. McGrath were present. Mrs. Miller was absent.

Others present were Fiscal Officer Caya, Fire Chief Shook, Robert Russell, Rick Arndt, Drew Raymond, Wendy Radatz, Gary Radatz and Bill Douglass.

Mr. McGrath made the motion and seconded by Mr. Mills to approve minutes from the June 11, 2025 Regular Meeting. Roll Call, all trustees voted yes. Motion passed.

Mr. McGrath made the motion and a second by Mr. Mills to approve bills for \$75,704.74 covered by E□payments E 144-2025 through 187-2025 and Warrants 23330 through 23369. Roll Call, all trustees voted yes. Motion passed.

#### Public Comment:

Gary Radatz stated he paid to have his culvert installed in 2020 and he was wondering when it will be done? Tim Mills said he will talk to the Road Dept. and it will be moved to the top of the list.

#### Fire:

Chief Shook reported there were 30 calls in the month of June in the Township. There were 8 accidents with 6 of those having injuries. The Traffic on West Maple has increased due to Route 20 being closed. Route 20 is scheduled to be open mid-September. Chief reported that they did have a water search but it ended up just being a guy fishing on a kayak. Tim Mills stated he went a removed a tree from the road.

#### Zoning Report:

Ron Cerjan reported he handled 4 permits in June. He also had 3 inquires about lot splits. He signed the paperwork that needs to go to the Planning Commission. Mr. Cerjan also said he received an email from a solar farm ding some research. He is also dealing with the junk on Auston Road, a complained about someone else putting up a fence on some else's property on North Ridge East and several calls on Air B-N-B's.

#### Road Department:

Savannah Workman is off today. The new employee has done his CDL class and testing. The Road crew doing their 10hour shifts in the summer has worked well and they have gotten a lot of work done. They have done a lot of pipe jobs and working on Walter Main. Joe has been very good at fixing things and has saved the Township a lot of money by doing things in house. They have been getting prices on outing in heat in the other building.

Fiscal Officer: Mrs. Caya went over the June month end financials. Ms. Caya reported the Tax Budget for the Township was submitted to the County.

New business:

Tim Mills reported that the Chip and Seal is scheduled to be completed on September 4<sup>th</sup>. Residents on Sylvan Road has contacted the Township about paving their Road. 6 out of 7 residents are willing to pay a portion of the paving cost. The estimated cost to pave the road is \$35,500.00 and the Township agreed to pay half of it. They would like to have it done next year about the houses are built.

Bill Douglas asked if there is a final draft of the Comprehensive Plan and what is the follow up plan? Tim Mills said that they just need to have their public hearing. He also asked if the Township has followed HB315 on enforcement? He also asked if the Township has found an attorney yet. Dave McGrath said he called a couple attorney's and they were not interested.

Tim Mills stated he will have to check with Tiffany on where the zoning and Wood and Lamping are at because she has been handling that.

Mr. McGrath made the motion and a second by Mr. Mills, there being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:25 AM. All trustees voted yes. Motion passed.
